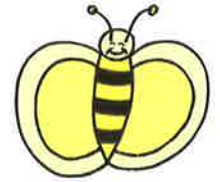

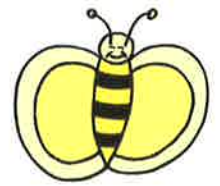
- Until the weather breaks, no student will be allowed outside for recess without the appropriate cold weather attire.
